



CONTRIBUTING TO ANC

There are a variety of ways people can contribute to the mission of ANC.

One way is by volunteering. Volunteers receive training in working with our clients on Thursday and Fridays, and also volunteers are needed on Wednesday evenings to prepare food packages.

Another is by financial donations, which will go to buy food (at hugely discounted prices) from the central Hawaii Foodbank.

ANC is also happy to accept donations of food. Canned meats such as Spam, tuna, and stews are particularly welcome, as are peanut butter and other nutritious items.

Personal hygiene items, such as soap, shampoo, and diapers are also welcome, since these kinds of items cannot be purchased with food stamps.

ANC participates in the annual "Taste of East Oahu" which is sponsored by Calvary-by-the-Sea Church as a fund-raiser for ANC, the youth program, and the Montessori School.

Every year for the annual Honolulu Marathon there is a group of runners who are sponsored by "virtual runners" to run for ANC. ANC is always looking for more actual and virtual Marathon runners.

ANC QUICK FACTS

ANC was founded in January 1989 by the late Ivy Olson.

It is a 501 (c3) non-profit organization with a self-perpetuating Board of Directors.

ANC's main service is as a foodbank, and it is the only such foodbank in East Oahu.

It operates with one full-time manager, Rodney "Mac" Macalino, and a number of regular volunteers.

Calvary-by-the-Sea Lutheran Church provides monthly financial support, as well as weekly contributions and volunteers who work at ANC.

Other churches and schools also make regular contributions to ANC and its mission.

In July 2010 ANC provided food for over 2,500 people. Only two years ago we provided food for about 500 people in a typical month. Community needs for food are rising rapidly!

ANC SERVICES

The foodbank is open every Thursday and Friday.

Other services include provision of a mailing address, a shower, and laundry facilities.

Although the major *raison d'être* of ANC is to support homeless people, we are finding an increasing number of elderly people on fixed incomes from our own Aina Haina neighborhood are now coming to the foodbank.

ANC also participates in "Operation Backpack," to collect school supplies for children whose parents are unable to afford them.

Every Thanksgiving Day ANC has a very large number of volunteers who donate and prepare food for a hot Thanksgiving dinner for ANC clients.

ANC AWARDS

ANC has won two major national awards.

ANC received an award from President George H. W. Bush.

ANC was also recognized by a "Thousand Points of Light" award, presented to ANC founder Ivy Olson by President Bill Clinton.
